HERO - ONE PLACE FOR ALL COMMUNICATION

Hero is a powerful and secure online sharing platform designed to reduce the number of places that parents need to check for information about school.

We use it at Te Puke Primary School:

- as our student management system (SMS)
- to share children's progress and next steps with whānau (reporting)
- as our primary means of communication with our school community

This year on the Hero App we have added links to our website and Facebook pages as well as the ability to report absences. We will also be using Hero this year to share your child's learning with you. We recommend that all TPPS whānau set up a login.

How to report an absence in Hero

If your child is going to be away for the day due to sickness, an appointment or any other reason, please notify the school as soon as possible by using the Te Puke Primary School Hero app. There is a 'Report an Absence' icon right on the homepage of the app 1. 2. Select "New User"

Your account will have been set up by school using the email address that you provided when you enrolled your child(ren), use this address to request a password. Please note: each contact must have their own email address.

3. Enter your email address

Select the "Request Password Link"

4. Check your email!

If one doesn't arrive, check that school has your correct details on file. You need to be using the same email address that we currently have on our school records.

5. Follow the secure link and enter your password.
